This has reference to letter no. F4(36)/DCPCR/2019-20/Advisory/8033 dated 14.10.2019 received from Ms. Rita Singh, Member, Delhi Commission for Protection of Child Rights (DCPCR), GNCTD. In the letter, the commission has desired that all the Universities should recognize the children who are coming from child care institutions under JJ Act for Care & Protection and facilitate them in their admissions, so that they could upgrade in their studies and achieve their goals. Many of these children are orphans or the children of parents who are not in a position to look after them due to social problems or less income. These children automatically fall in the category of Economically Weaker Sections or Below Poverty Line, as they have no income. Hence, the requirement of obtaining income certificate from Revenue Authorities may be exempted for such children for all purposes such as scholarships, financial assistance etc.

All the Deans/Principals/Directors of USS/Institutes/Colleges are requested to kindly adhere to the above directions of DCPCR, GNCTD.
