### **Dr. S. Natesh**

Retd. Senior Advisor (Scientist-H), DBT, Govt. of India, New Delhi

Dr. Natesh, is an eminent botanist, teacher and scientist by profession and passion. Serving as a scientist in DBT since 1984, he accomplished several new and novel programmes nationally and internationally. Editor-in-chief of DBT's bimonthly Newsletter *Biotech News*. He also launched and led the campaign to bring overseas Indian bioscientists back to India through the *Ramalingaswami Re-entry Fellowship* programme. Until recently, he was Senior Consultant & Project Coordinator, DST centre for Policy Research IIT-Delhi.

Dr. Natesh received '**Biospectrum Lifetime Achievement Award**' (2012) for his contribution towards taking the Indian Biosciences Sector to new heights. A new plant species, *Aponogeton nateshii*, has been named in his honour (2015).
