M.Sc. Biodiversity and Conservation is a professional, postgraduate course. The course provides students with essential knowledge, skills and experience in conservation biology and in the management and sustainable use of natural resources. It provides a cutting-edge practical approach to the ecological principles and methodologies that are fundamental to biodiversity management and the conservation of species and habitats. It is career orienting in nature which opens a lot of scopes for them after its completion.

STRENGTH OF THE PROGRAMME

The academicians have deep core knowledge and expertise in conserving biodiversity in a sustainable manner. The course is organised into three semesters of coursework along with a final semester of field research projects and thesis preparation. The course provides:
