O R D E R

Under its outreach programme, GGSIP University has adopted Pochanpur and Amberhai villages to work in tandem with the office bearers of these villages to improve the overall ambiance of these villages with an attempt to improve quality life of the residents of these villages and to bring them in whatever way at par with academic facilities which are available in other parts of the city.

In furtherance of this mission, a meeting was convened by District Magistrate (South West) under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Member of Parliament on July 8th 2024, which was attended by the Vice Chancellor of Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University (GGSIPU), and other officers of the University. The primary objective of the visit cum meeting was to assess the existing infrastructure available in these villages namely Pochanpur and Amberhai and to identify key areas for development and to strategize the initiatives, which are essentially needed to upgrade the existing facilities and civic amenities in such a manner so as to have quantitative as well as qualitative visible impact.

Based on the inputs gathered and after the interaction with the office bearer of these villages, the University has identified the certain areas, as per details given below, keeping in view its limited financial resources to augment the existing infrastructure and also to contribute academically to bring the resident of these areas in the main stream to the best possible way :

A. Infrastructure Development

- I. **Renovation of Village SC/ST Chaupals**
 - Renovate village chaupals to enhance community spaces.
- II. **Rain Water Harvesting**
 - Set up rainwater harvesting systems at suitable locations to address water scarcity.
- III. **Park Beautification**
 - Beautify parks and install Benches, Swings and other Recreational facilities.
- IV. **Signage Installation**
 - Install signage indicating lane and house numbers to improve navigation.

V. **Composting Pits**

- Develop composting pits for organic waste management and produce organic compost.

VI. **Solar Lighting**

- Install solar-powered street lights to enhance safety and reduce electricity costs.

VII. **Public Toilets**

- Construct public toilets to improve sanitation and hygiene.

For the smooth execution of above mentioned work, the Competent Authority, GGSIP University is pleased to nominate Superintendent Engineer, University Works Division as Chief Nodal Officer for the execution of infrastructural development activities contemplated in above villages adopted by the University.


