## **ADMISSION NOTICE FOR PROGRAMME M.PHARM (CET Code: 189) IN CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE IN PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES (CEPS), GGSIP UNIVERSITY**

The University is introducing a new programme **M.Pharm** (CET Code: 189) as approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) for the Academic Session 2024-25. The details of M.Pharm programme, duration and eligibility etc., for admission in this programme is given below:

### **2. Seat Allocation:**

- 85% of the total sanctioned intake for Delhi Region**

- **15% of the total sanctioned intake for Outside Delhi Region**

The candidates shall be considered as **Outside Delhi Region Candidates** if they have passed the qualifying examination from any school/institute located Outside Delhi. All such candidates shall be treated as **Outside Delhi Region Candidates** for the purpose of counseling for admission.


**3. Reservation:** As per the University norms as mentioned in Under Graduate Admission Brochure 2024-25.
