### **About the Program**

The JN Tata Endowment extends financial assistance to Indian students who wish to pursue Postgraduate/Doctoral/Postdoctoral studies overseas. Students who are selected for the Ioan scholarship may also be recommended for a partial 'Travel Grant' and a 'Gift Award' which is linked to their academic performance in their overseas studies, at the sole discretion of the Trustees of the concerned Trusts.

### Eligibility

- Open for Indian citizens under 45 years old as of June 30, 2025.
- Graduates of a recognised Indian university with at least 60% marks on average in their undergraduate or postgraduate studies.
- Candidates who have completed at least one undergraduate degree OR those who are in the final year of any undergraduate programme at a recognised university/college/institution in India.
- Candidates admitted to the course recognised as a Graduate Program (postgraduate in Indian terminology).
- Candidates already pursuing postgraduate studies abroad may apply at the end of their first year or the start of the second, provided at least 12 months of study remain at the time of the award (typically in July).
